	Romans 11:1 (ESV) ¹ I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin.
	God's foreknowing is fore <i>choosing</i> .
	Romans 11:2a (ESV) ² God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew.
	Romans 8:29 (ESV) ²⁹ For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

	Romans 11:1-2b-4 (ESV) ^{2b} Do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah , how he appeals to God against Israel? ³ "Lord, they have killed your prophets, they have demolished your altars, and I alone am left, and they seek my life."
