Why it Takes More Than Good Works to Communicate the Gospel
God's chosen method is
1 Corinthians 1:21 (ESV)  21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe.  Romans 10:17 (ESV)  17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.
People must with words.
Romans 10:13-14 (ESV)  13 For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."  14 How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?
