Remember Who You Are – And Whose You Are

2 Corinthians 6:14-16 (ESV)

¹⁴ <u>Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers</u>. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? ¹⁵ What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever? ¹⁶ What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

The context:

The **command**: Do not be "unequally yoked" ...

Deuteronomy 22:10 (ESV)

¹⁰ You shall not plow with an ox and a donkey together.

A whole Bible principle for God's people:

To Abraham – "Go from your country, your kindred, and your father's house" (Gen. 12:1)

In the Promised Land – "You shall not do as they do in the land of Egypt, where you lived, and you shall not do as they do in the land of Canaan, to which I am bringing you." (Lev. 18:3)

In Judges – "You shall make no covenant with the inhabitants of this land." (Judges 2:2)

Regarding Jesus – "... he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." (John 10:3)

Peter @ Pentecost – "Save yourselves from this crooked generation." (Acts 2:40)

In the Last Days – "Come out of her, my people, lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues ..." (Rev. 18:4)

The principle?
5 reasons:
Righteousness and lawlessness cannot be
Light and darkness cannot be in
Christ and the devil cannot be in
A believer and non-believer cannot share spiritual
The temple of God cannot house .

An command with a promise:

2 Corinthians 6:17-18 (ESV)

 17 Therefore go out from their midst, and be separate from them, says the Lord, and touch no unclean thing; then <u>I will welcome you</u>, 18 and <u>I will be a father to you</u>, and <u>you shall be sons and daughters to me</u>, says the Lord Almighty."
