Mark 1:21-28

²¹ And they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath he entered the synagogue and was teaching. ²² And they were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one who had authority, and not as the scribes. ²³ And immediately there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, ²⁴ “What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? In the time of Jesus, there were many teachers (rabbis) who had many followers. What made Jesus' teaching and teachings unique? In a word, authority.

Mark's Gospel declares, "... they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with authority!"

In the words of Matthew Henry, Jesus taught "as one that knew the mind of God, and was commissioned to declare it." No other rabbi could do this. Instead they appealed to the authority of the Sanhedrin (ruling religious council), other respected rabbis, or maybe even the High Priest. But Jesus – the Son of God – showed and spoke the very power of God with authority!

Our guest speaker today is Dr. Danny Akin, President of Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary. He will be teaching from Mark 1:21-34. In his message, we'll learn how The Unparalleled Authority of Jesus still dominates our world, our times, our situations, and our lives as well!
