In this way, we aim to pray as our Lord prayed: in the Spirit.”

Jonathan Edwards is probably most known for his powerfully convicting sermon "*Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God*" which he preached during the time of America's First Great Awakening. Perhaps even more convicting however is a far lesser-known sermon of Edwards' called: "*Hypocrites Deficient in the Duty of Prayer*".

In it, Edwards said, "Prayer is as natural an expression of faith as breathing is of life; and to say a man lives a life of faith, and yet lives a prayerless life, is every whit as inconsistent and incredible, as to say, that a man lives without breathing. A prayerless life is so far from being a holy life, that it is a profane life. He that lives so, lives like a heathen, who calleth not on God's name; he that lives a prayerless life, lives without God in the world."

In today's message, *Our Praying King*, we'll explore a bit of the prayer life of Jesus and what it can teach us about love, faith, power, and experiencing God in this world.

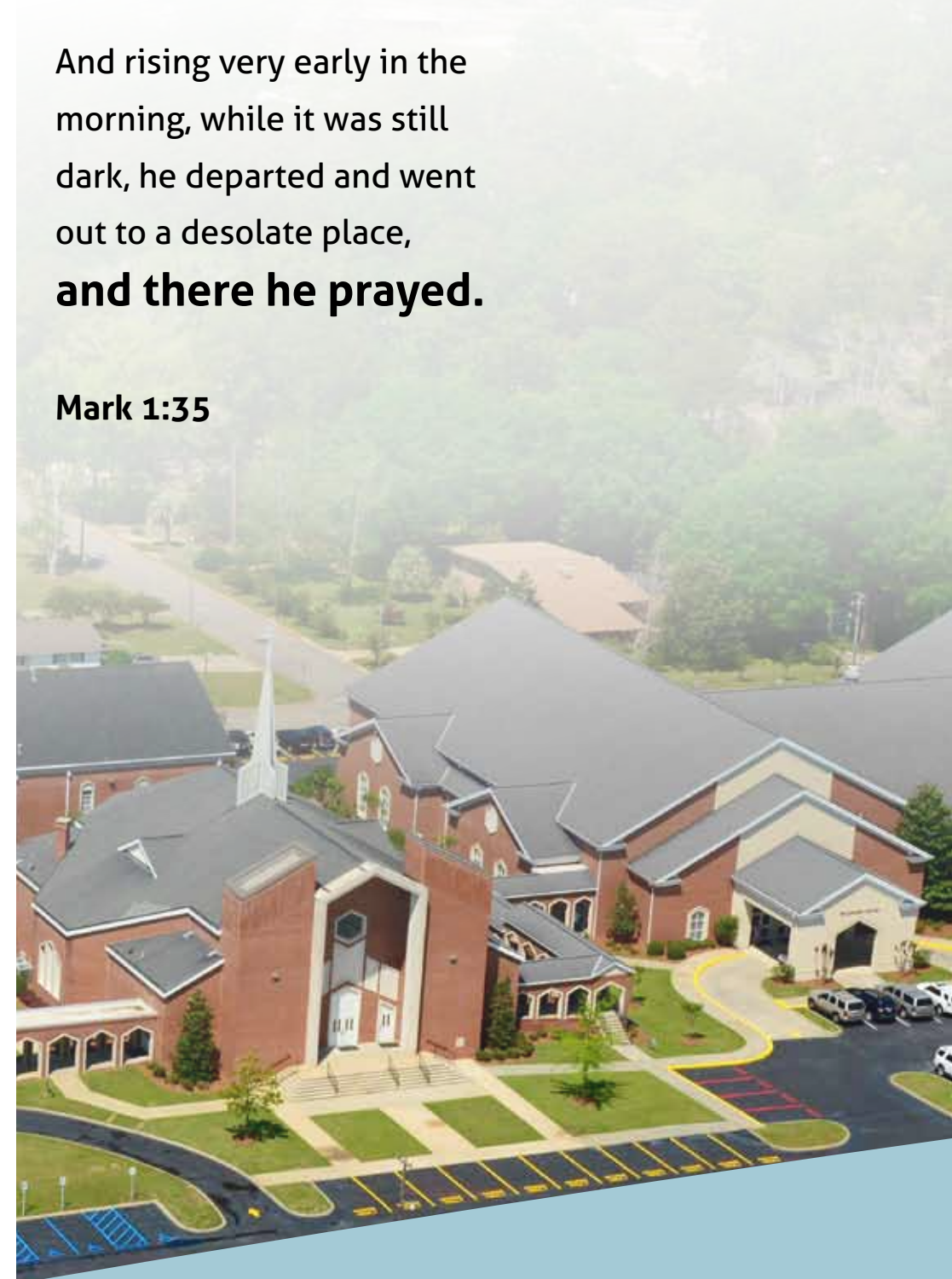
