But all along, God's plan and purpose was not only to provide that substitute, but to be that substitute in the person of his Son, bearing in himself the punishment we could not bear and the shame we could not overcome ... the story of penal substitutionary atonement is the story of the passionate expression of God's love. It is the pinnacle of his glory. Lose penal substitution, and we not only lose the story of redemption, we lose the love and glory of God.

One of my all-time favorite songs/hymns is How Deep the Father’s Love for Us by Stuart Townend. This is verse 3:

I will not boast in anything,

No gifts, no power, no wisdom;

But I will boast in Jesus Christ,

His death and resurrection.

Why should I gain from His reward?

I cannot give an answer;

But this I know with all my heart –

His wounds have paid my ransom.

The cross of Christ is simultaneously tragic and glorious for those of us who believe. The tragedy of our sin that “held him there” (v.2) coupled with the awe-inspiring, faith-creating love of God on full display is both shocking and amazing.

In today’s message, *The Price of Glory*, we will consider again what God in the flesh did *for us* to make a way to glory for us. We will ponder his intentional, voluntary sacrifice and his life-changing, world-shaking resurrection – and we will boast in it! He paid the price for glory for our sake.

Then, we will examine what he expects *from us* on the way to that place of glory. While heaven is assured for all who are in Christ, not all receive the same reward. There is a way to greatness in the eyes of God and it is not like the path to “greatness” in this world.

What is the price? And, are you willing to pay it? One way or another, we’ll all answer both questions today.

We are glad you are here, and we hope that you hear the voice of God through the Word of God by way of the Spirit of God!

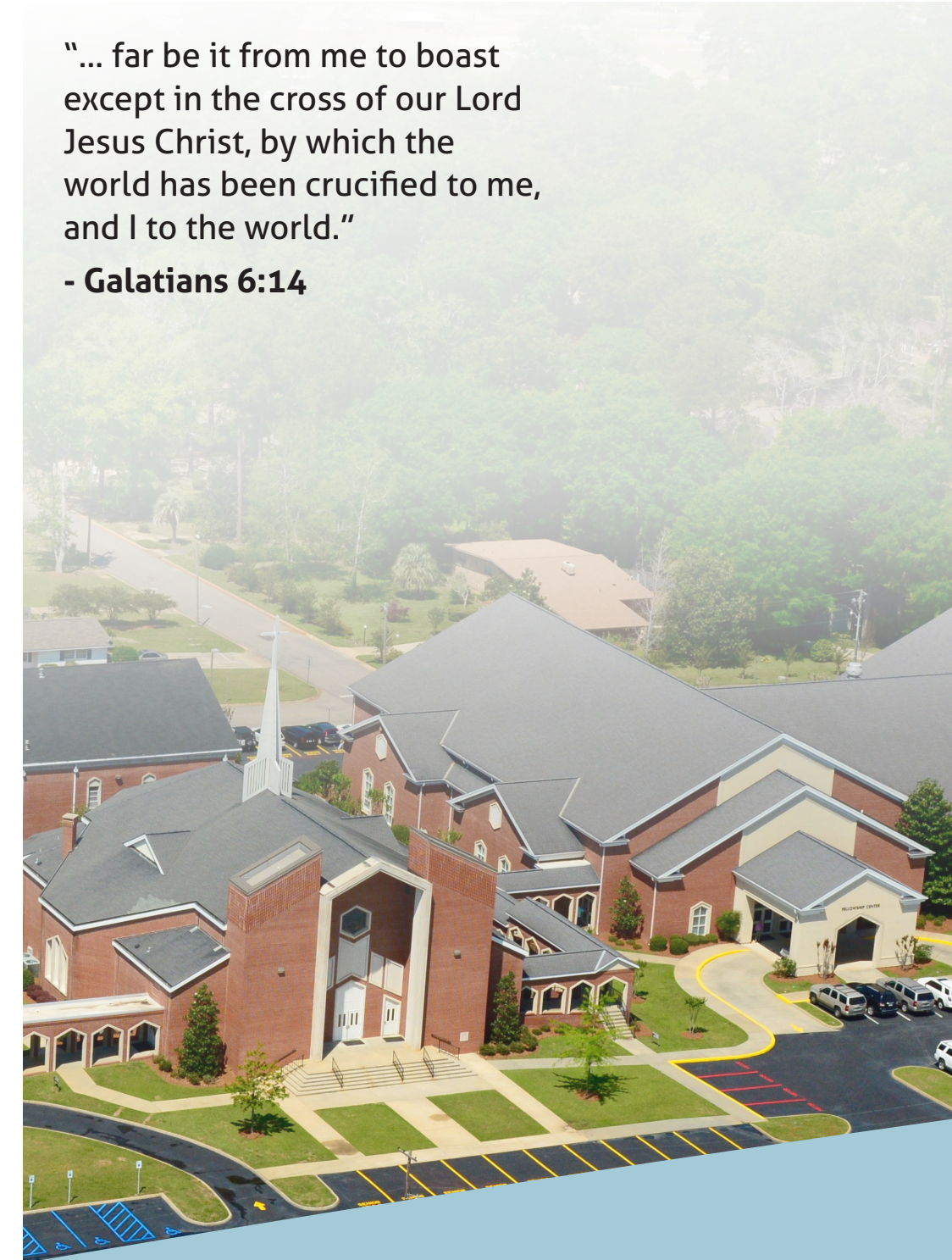
