One of the most paradigm-shifting, worldview-altering, perspective-changing, conviction-bringing books I’ve ever read is Radical by David Platt. Several months before encountering that great book, I read Platt’s companion to Radical, The Radical Question: What Is Jesus Worth to You? As you might guess, Platt challenges the watered down version of ‘Christianity’ so often practiced in America and contrasts it with the robust, all-in, hold-nothing-back, give-your-life-away call to follow Christ we find in the Gospels. At the conclusion of the little book, he says this:

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our trust—even though we may not always be safe in this world, we will always be secure in his hands.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our plans—he alone knows what is best for our lives, and we will follow him wherever, however, and whenever he leads.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our obedience—his word demands total allegiance, so when he speaks, we will respond without question or hesitation.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our dreams—he has created us for so much more than acclaim in this world, and we will settle for nothing less than his fame in all the world.

Is Jesus worth this to you?

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our possessions—he has given them to us, not so we will indulge ourselves with more stuff, but so we will spend ourselves on behalf of those in spiritual and physical need.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our desire—he is utterly satisfying, and we have no need to seek the pleasures of this world, because we have found ultimate delight in him.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our affections—he has loved us completely, so we will adore him supremely.

Let’s believe that Jesus is worthy of all our lives—we will gladly lose them in this world because our eyes are fixed on the world to come.
