3 Critical, Post-Resurrection Realities We Are Sure Of:
Jesus
(Matthew 26:16-17, Luke 24:33-37, John 20:19-20, Acts 1:3, 1 Corinthians 15:3-7)
Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene, the women that came to Jesus' tomb (Mary the Mother of James, Salome, and Joanna), Peter, and two disciples on the Emmaus road. He also appeared to the remainder of the Twelve Disciples with Thomas absent and later present. He appeared to seven disciples on the Sea of Galilee. He appeared to over five hundred people at the same time. He appeared to James. Finally Jesus appeared to Saul of Tarsus - the man who became the Apostle Paul.

The reason Christ can "save [us] to the uttermost" is not only because he died on earth, but because "he always lives to make intercession for us" in heaven (Heb. 7:23–25). The fact that Jesus has ascended into heaven and sat down is proof that his work on the cross was successful.

"Easter changes everything!"

How often have you heard that phrase? I'm afraid we've said it so often and so easily that it's almost become trite or clichéd. What do we mean by it? More importantly, what has Easter changed in you?

According to John Piper, there are at least 5 effects of our union with Christ thru His resurrection:

1) We share in Christ's indestructible life.

There is a new security, a new confidence of hope in our lives. Christians are, in a profound sense, immortal. We will never see the full destructive power of death, because Jesus said in John 11:25–26, "I am the resurrection and the life.

- .. Everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die."
- 2) We receive a new identity.

Colossians 3:3–4: "You have died, and your life is hidden with Christ [the risen Christ] in God." That's where you are; that's who you are.

3) We experience unceasing help.

In union with the risen Christ, we have a new, living, present friend helping us all the time. Jesus said to his disciples before he died, "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you" (John 14:18).

- 4) We have the power to live righteously. In union with the risen Christ, there is new power for defeating sin and walking in righteousness. The key text is Romans 6 and the first part of chapter 7.
- 5) We can suffer well with our Savior.

In union with the risen Christ, there is a new power to suffer with Jesus. Philippians 3:10: "that I may know him and the power of his resurrection." Why? That I "may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death."

So yes, everything has changed for us in Christ because of His resurrection!

In today's message, Living in Light of Easter, we'll consider 4 clear implications of Jesus' resurrection in the life of every Christian, from how we think to what we do. I pray you are challenged and encouraged by God's Word and Spirit.
