Jesus: God's Final Word **Our High Priest Forever**

Hebrews 7:23-28

Context ...

In chapters 4 and 5, we discovered a portion of Jesus' ministry as our high priest: He is a truly human being, tempted in every respect just like we are, and he can therefore sympathize fully with our weakness and the pressures we find ourselves under. Not only that, Jesus knows sin far better than we do since he fought temptation to the end and won. He never gave in.

But now we've discovered far more ...

We've learned that Jesus,	through his _	(Hebrews 7:15-17), is

Three big ideas ... Uttermost, Intercession, Fitting

Uttermost ...

There is no part of our existence that our salvation does not touch. From beginning to end, he will save us ___, ____, and ____

Intercession ...

Jesus intercedes for us by his once-and-for-all ______ (more of that theme will be explored in coming chapters), but he also intercedes for us ______ before the Father! John Owen:

The safest conception . . . that we can have of the intercession of Christ . . . is his continual appearance for us in the presence of God by virtue of his office as the "high priest over the house of God," representing the efficacy of his oblation [outpouring of blood], accompanied with tender care, love, and desires for the welfare, supply, deliverance and salvation of the church.

Fitting ...

_ that we _____, Jesus has and is. Jesus "fits" us. We are sinners. He is holy. We are guilty. He is innocent. We are stained. He is unstained. We are sinners in the company of sinners. He is sinless and unlike us. We are lowly and He is exalted.

Jesus – and Jesus alone – makes it possible for us to reach and fulfill every _____ God has for us.

Jesus – and Jesus alone – enables us to enter into deep and lasting ______ with and _____ of God.

But there's more: Jesus "_____" God.

Remember that Hebrews 1:3 told us of Jesus:

"He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high ..."

Jesus is all that he is ("holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens"), not just because he fits all of our needs. He is all that he is because he is altogether God.

And finally, Jesus – and Jesus alone – "_____" us for _____

It seems to me that the majority of gospel presentations I've heard throughout my life and even the majority of the descriptions of Jesus and his saving work tend to center on man (or me). It's my needs that are focused on, my lack of fulfillment, happiness, purpose, or quality of life. And even when those messages aren't as superficial as "you need Jesus because your life isn't all you want it to be" kind of messages, they still only deal with me ... my separation from God, my sinful struggles and hangups, and even my eternal state. While those things are certainly true about me – or anyone who is still in their sin and lost in a state of unforgiveness (we are separated from God, we are in bondage to our sins, we are eternally separated from God and judgment bound apart from Christ), there's more to the story! Hebrews 7:26 tells us, "For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens." One way of reading that is to know that Jesus "fits" us and is exactly who and what we need. We are sinners. He is holy. We are guilty. He is innocent. We are stained. He is unstained. We are sinners in the company of sinners. He is sinless and unlike us. We are lowly and He is exalted. You get the idea. And, if we read the text that way, we would not be wrong. We desperately need everything that Jesus is, for He is our substitute in every way (Hebrews 2:8-10) and without his sinless holiness, we would not reach God (Hebrews 12:14). But we would not be reading the text for all the God-

glorifying worth that it holds for us. You see, Hebrews 7:23-28 says in three different places that Jesus is "forever". That means that before we were, Jesus was. He pre-exists not only us, but our sin. Ephesians 1:3-4 tells us,

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world ..." That tells us that God did not simply react to our sin and offer a contingency response to it. He knew our choice to sin would be made, and made again and again. He planned our salvation out of mercy and grace anyway! And when Hebrews 7:26 tells us that "it is fitting" that Jesus is as he is, it also means that he is *befitting* who God is! Remember that Hebrews 1:3 told us of Jesus:

"He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high ..."

the end..." (Hebrews 6:12). him! He is our forever!




