Over the last 3 months, a state-wide government bus strike has been going on and many bus drivers/staff have been out of work. For about a month one of the local pastors I partner with has been praying, planning and asking about doing a food distribution that can meet real needs while also getting the Gospel out to 50 families affected in area. All are unbelievers from a mix of religious communities – mainly Hindu, Muslim (Shaikh included) and Buddhist backgrounds. [Saturday] February 5th they conducted the food distribution and were able to share the Gospel with the 50 families. The pastor has partnered with several Christian men to follow up with the families in the weeks to come in hopes of people coming to Christ and Bible studies beginning in their homes. Calvary Baptist Church's funds have been used to provide the food for the distribution and also to train the pastor and the Christians he is partnering with for the follow-up ministry.
