In today's message, we get to interact with one of the most powerful sermons ever preached. Immediately after being filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter proclaims the gospel powerfully and effectively. A truly transformed man empowered by the Spirit of God preaches a clear gospel of transformation. And thousands become followers of Jesus as a result.

It's critical for us today to have a well-rounded, biblically precise understanding of the Gospel. If not, we can't rightly answer the questions: "How can I enter the kingdom? How can I be saved? What do I have to do to inherit eternal life?", etc.

The following is a helpful gospel synopsis I've been reading. It's consistent with our previous studies of Mark, Hebrews, and now Acts.

"The gospel is that Jesus the king ...

preexisted as God the Son,

was sent by the Father,

took on human flesh in fulfillment of God's promises to David,

died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, was buried,

was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

appeared to many witnesses,

is enthroned at the right hand of God as the ruling Christ,

has sent the Holy Spirit to his people to effect his rule,

and will come again as final judge to rule.

The gospel is the true story of how Jesus the Son was sent by God the Father to become the saving king who now rules forever at his right hand through the sending of the Holy Spirit, fulfilling God's promises in Scripture.

The purpose of the gospel is allegiance to Jesus the king in all the nations. Allegiance is expressed in repentance, trusting loyalty (faith), and baptism...

We must not confuse the gospel itself with its saving benefits. The gospel proper announces possible saving benefits. But only those who respond to the gospel by giving allegiance actualize these special benefits. These include forgiveness of sins, righteousness (justification), adoption, glory, and so on. Special saving benefits are received personally only when we give allegiance and receive the Holy Spirit. This unites us to others who already possess these benefits—the true church."
