Ten years ago, and just a few weeks into my new season of ministry at Calvary Baptist Church after moving from Jensen Beach, FL, I was already feeling the weight of the challenge of change before me, coupled with the great sense of loss of all things comfortable and familiar that 17 years of ministry in one place affords. On March 21, 2012, after prayer and scripture reading, I wrote the following verse from my quiet time that day atop my journal: "Do what the occasion requires, for God is with you ..." (1 Samuel 10:17).

At that moment, God was reminding me of the sense of His call that brought me here and was renewing the sense of purpose necessary to be effective at what He called me to do, where He called me to do it. I felt the comfort of His presence assuring me to press on. I'm pretty sure now as I look back that many people I knew (and many I didn't yet) were praying for me in those days. Without those prayers, that God-sent reminder and renewal may never have come, and these last ten years may have looked very different for my family and me.

It's been ten years now since those early days, and whatever challenges we've faced have been matched by faithful praying. Whatever successes we've experienced are due to the same. And whatever Kingdom impact we will have in the future on our city and the world will have the same source: Our sovereign God responding to the prayers of His faithful, righteous people.

At the 10-year mark, I want to thank you for your love for me and mine and being a family to us. This month particularly, I especially thank you for your texts, calls, and notes of encouragement and support. I mostly appreciate your faithfulness to God, and your love for His Son, His Word, and His church, and your prayers.

As I begin my second decade with and among you all, I ask for this the most: That you pray for me. You may not always agree with me, but will vou pray for me? You may not always understand me, but will you pray for me? You may not always like me, but will you pray for me?

I ask this of you because this is what (imperfect) I desire: To walk more closely with God every day than the

day before. To be filled with, empowered by, and submissive to the Holy Spirit.

To lead, love, and care for my family well. To preach and teach the truth without fear of man or pride in myself.

And to pastor the people of Calvary with integrity, zeal, focus, and wisdom until God says otherwise.

As Proverbs 16:9 tells us, "The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps."

Pray that He would establish mine.
