"an interference with nature by supernatural power." (C.S. Lewis)

"an event in the external world that is wrought by the immediate power of God." (J.G. Machen)

"an observed event that triggers awareness of God's presence and power." (J.I. Packer)

God's primary purpose for the miracles he worked through men was ...

"to authenticate his messengers as bearing a true revelation from God." (John MacArthur)

"to give evidence that God is truly at work and serve the advance of the gospel." (Wayne Grudem)

"to help bring people to Christ" (John Piper)
