Paul's 4th Defense:

The Jews had two years of pent-up frustration aimed at Paul.

But once again, their charges against Paul were baseless and unprovable.

Paul's defense was simple: "I have committed no offense whatsoever ..."

In weakness, and to curry favor with the Jews, Festus was unjustly willing to send him back to Jerusalem.

But Paul boldly appeals to Rome and to Caesar himself!

Paul trusted the Lord and was willing to do whatever He required of him at any personal cost!

The following night the Lord stood by him and said, "Take courage, for as you have testified to the facts about me in Jerusalem, so you must testify also in Rome." (Acts 23:11)

Prepare to Hear God's Word

How can you best prepare to hear God's word on the Lord's Day? Here are four suggestions:

- 1. Throughout the week, meditate on the passage that will be preached on Sunday. Pray for your pastor as he prepares his sermon. Pray that he'll meet with God, hear from God, and speak accurately of God. Take notes on the text. Ask questions of the text. Pray through the text. Doing these things will increase your appetite for the Word
- 2. Prepare for Sunday morning. On Saturday night or Sunday morning, pray for your upcoming opportunity to hear God's Word preached. Pray that your heart would be soft and humble before it. Also, prepare by getting adequate rest on Saturday night! Treat Sunday as a "big day"! The gathering of the people of God for the worship of God centered around the Word of God is a big deal!
- 3. Talk and pray about the message with friends after church. Start conversations at lunch by asking, "How did the Scripture challenge or speak to you today?" Encourage others by sharing what you learned about God and his Word during the sermon. Talk to others about how you can specifically apply what you learned in the week ahead. Do this with your family, those you are discipling, and with your small group.
- 4. Meditate and act on the sermon you heard throughout the week. Don't let the Sunday sermon become a one-time event that fades from memory as soon as it is over (James 1:22-25). Review your sermon notes with friends or family. Choose one or two applications from the Scripture and prayerfully put them into practice over the coming week. We do more than study God's Word. We live it!
