John 18:37-38a (ESV)

Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?"

Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

3 Flawed Responses to the Truth:

4 reasons why a commitment to *OBJECTIVE, HISTORICAL, UNIVERSAL* truth matters so much:

1. Because Jesus ...

John 18:37b (ESV)

"For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world — **to bear witness to the truth**. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

2. Because it is our responsibility as the church to ...

1st Timothy 3:15 (ESV)

... the household of God, which is the church of the living God, **a pillar and buttress of the truth**.

3. Because wrong beliefs ...

Ephesians 4:17-19 (ESV)

¹⁷ Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the **futility of their minds**. ¹⁸ They are **darkened in their understanding**, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. ¹⁹ They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to **practice every kind of impurity**.

4. Because ultimately, the truth ...

Romans 1:18-20 (ESV)

¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness **suppress the truth**. ¹⁹ For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. ²⁰ For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. **So they are without excuse**.

John 8:31-32 (ESV)

³¹ So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³² and **you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free**."

Jesus is TRUTH.
