Corporate worship – that time and space where the church gathers to worship God - isn't meant to be a spectator sport where people come to take their seats in the stands to be entertained with singing and a funny, relevant message. Unfortunately, too many people attend church like they attend their favorite sports game: as season ticket holders to a spectator sport. But like baseball [or any sport], corporate worship is meant for participating, not spectating.

Various churches have attempted to make corporate worship more participatory...The desire to help congregants participate in corporate worship is a good desire. That said, [many times] these attempts My Decision Today: miss the purpose of our corporate gathering.

We gather to meet with God together. God always intended that we would know him better through our engagement with others, but we don't want our engagement with others to eclipse engaging with God. So it's crucial that God's Word remain central to our gathering. We hear the Word preached, sang, and read. And in response, we pray. We gather to meet with him together in large part through **pravers** that are responses to his Word.




