Jesus is making it plain how the issue of misplaced anger is.		
And what's an expression – short of murder, but still sinful – of an angry heart?		
And remember the issue is never of me! When it comes to my anger, the root cause is always the condition of my (Prov 4:23, Mark 7:20-23)		
Addressing the Root (Heart) Causes of My Anger:		
Pray for (Rom. 12:1–2; Phil. 1:9–11).		
Check my (Prov 16:32, 19:11)		
Surrender my (James 4:1-2)		
Confess my (Psalm 37:8-9)		
Choose to (Prov. 19:11, Col 3:13)		
Trust God's (Nahum 1:3, Psalm 37:7-9, Rom 12:19-21)		
Don't up or up. Instead, take steps to address the cause and seek God-honoring, and do it with (Prov 29:11, James 1:19-20)
