Implications and Applications:

Jesus this exception clause because of the very of marriage: It is a union. Violating that union is "porneia" (translated here "").
Jesus but does not divorce for the cause of sexual infidelit Adultery doesn't <i>necessarily</i> put a marriage beyond repair. God's is great.
If there is no cause for a divorce, and a person remarries, that is (adultery).
If there a is a legitimate of marriage (divorce), then may be possible.


June Missions Spotlight B and M (Global Missions Partner)
