# The Worth of My Words Matthew 5:33-37 The Law and the true intent of God: "Again you have heard ..., but I say to you ..." Three presuppositions: 1) Jesus – as divine \_\_\_\_\_ – truly knows the true \_\_\_\_\_ of Scripture. (His Word is infallible). 2) The Pharisees subverted \_\_\_\_\_ teaching to make it \_\_\_\_\_ and advantageous for them. You shall serve him and hold fast to him, and by his name you shall swear. (Deut. 10:20) And it shall come to pass, if they will diligently learn the ways of my people, to swear by my name, 'As the Lord lives,' even as they taught my people to swear by Baal, then they shall be built up in the midst of my people. (Jer. 12:16-17) Vows – once made\* - were \_\_\_\_ You shall not swear by my name falsely, and so profane the name of your God ... (Lev. 19:12) If a man vows a vow to the Lord, or swears an oath to bind himself by a pledge, he shall not break his word. He shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth. (Num 30:2) But wait ... Pharisaical/rabbinic aberrations\*: Oaths/vows are not binding if they do not include \_\_\_\_\_\_. Oaths/vows are only as significant as what was \_\_\_\_\_ by. Result?
