2 Questions – 1 King
Two questions reveal one truth: Jesus is the King above every king, the Sovereign over every sovereign.

A King Greater than Caesar (22:15–22)
The question: "Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?" (v. 17)
The tax: An admission – "We are Caesar's _____."
The coin: BLASPHEMY codified in silver
The answer: "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." (v. 21).
The implication: Caesar may lay claim to _____, but Christ lays claim to _____. Caesar's reign is _____ and _____. Christ's is _____ and _____.

A King Greater than David (22:41–46)
The question: "What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" (v. 42).
The psalm: The LORD said to my Lord, 'Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet.'" (Psalm 110:1)
The answer: If the Messiah is David's son, yet David calls Him Lord, then He must be more than a descendant — He must be _____ than David himself.
The implication: The Messiah is not just David's son but David's _____ — not an earthly deliverer but the eternal Son of God whose reign is universal and without end.
