The Cost of Our Response to Christ

"No one meets Jesus with indifference."

There is no neutrality.

Every response to Jesus will cost you something.

The question is: Is the cost worth it?

The Costly Choice of the Chief Priests & Elders (v. 3-5)

The cost: A forfeited _____ to remain _____

They rejected Jesus because His _____ threatened *their* authority.

Embracing Him would have meant surrendering the throne of their own lives.

So, to protect their power, pride, and control, they chose to eliminate the King rather than bow to Him.

The Costly Choice of the Woman with the Alabaster Flask (v. 6-13)

The cost: A priceless _____ extravagantly poured out

Matthew doesn't name the woman who anointed Jesus, but John tells us it was _____, the sister of Lazarus.

Mary took an alabaster jar—made from soft, translucent stone and typically reserved for a family's most valuable oils, and poured its perfume, valued at almost a _____ salary, onto Jesus.

The disciples look at her act and call it "waste."

Why?

"Nothing poured out on Jesus is ever wasted.

Anything withheld from Him always is."

They saw _____.

And Jesus calls her act "a beautiful thing."

What is a "beautiful thing" I can do to Jesus?

The Costly Choice of Judas Iscariot (V. 14-16)

The cost: Spiritual _____ for trivial gain

Matthew tells us that Judas went to the chief priests and asked a chilling question: "What will you give me?"

The priests offer him **30 pieces of silver**; the compensation required in Exodus 21:32 if someone's slave was gored by an ox. That is the legal value of a _____.

That is what Judas accepted as the price tag on his Messiah.

The cost of that choice was catastrophic. Judas gained a handful of coins and lost his _____.

He gained a brief satisfaction of greed and stepped into eternal judgment. He gained a moment of control and plunged into despair, leading to his suicide.

People still trade Jesus for lesser things.

Judas shows us where that road leads.
