GLOBAL MISSIONS **\$266,000 / YEAR**

Too often, the majority of resources God has entrusted to His church remain where Jesus is already known. We want to change that at Calvary and be poised and able to support missionaries (and to send short-term missionaries) where the needs are greatest.

LOCAL MISSIONS & CHURCH PLANTING **\$170,000 / YEAR**

As we are discovering the need and worth of church planting, we long to be able to expand this work in multiple locations, near and far. Your generosity will help get the Gospel to hard places in our city and beyond.

CAPITAL NEEDS **\$100,000 / YEAR**

Our physical plant has grown tremendously since those early days back in the 1950's. And while we are committed to growing people and not buildings, we know that future capital needs will require significant investment. Whether those needs are new acquisitions due to growth, or major maintenance and refurbishing, we want to be able and ready to respond.

FUTURE LEADERS **\$50,000 / YEAR**

We long to see pastors, missionaries, and Gospel-focused leaders develop among us and go out from us. We want to be able to invest in their education, training, and success. We want to help equip them, send them, and support them.

CALVARY CARES **\$70,000 / YEAR**

The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering® is an annual offering collected by believers around the world to support international missions. The offering was officially named in 1918 by Woman's Missionary Union in honor of the missionary to China who urged churches to start it and give sacrificially.

This offering is unique from other mission offerings in that 100% of gifts provide for missionaries all over the world. It is a valuable part of Southern Baptists' 175-year history of reaching the nations with the gospel and vital to reaching the vision of a multitude from every language, people, tribe and nation.


They entrusted this Legacy to us.


